A woman has died following a road traffic collision in Bungay.

Police were called by the ambulance service at just before 3:00pm yesterday, Tuesday 28 May, to reports of a collision involving a bicycle and a HGV vehicle on St John's Road in the town, near to the junction of Hillside Road West. The cyclist, a woman, was sadly pronounced dead at the scene. Next of kin have been informed.

The road remained closed to allow an investigation into the circumstances of the collision to continue and local diversions have been put in place.

Anyone who may have witnessed the collision, or the manner of driving prior to the incident, should contact the Serious Collision Investigation Team at Suffolk Police on 101, quoting reference CAD 188 of 28 May.
