A man who was arrested following a fatal road traffic collision in Bungay has been released from police custody pending further enquires.

Officers were called just before 3pm on Tuesday 28 May, to reports of a collision involving a bicycle and a HGV vehicle on St John's Road in the town, near to the junction of Hillside Road West.

Ambulance crews were also in attendance but the cyclist, a woman in her 70s, was sadly pronounced dead at the scene.

A 35-year-old man was arrested on suspicion of causing death by dangerous driving. He was taken to Bury St Edmunds Police Investigation Centre for questioning and has now been released under investigation.

Any witnesses, or anyone with information about this incident, are asked to contact the Serious Collision Investigation Team on 101 quoting reference CAD 188 of 28 May.
