I am pleased to announce that on Sat 8th April we had the Special Roads Policing Team in Bungay. This is a task force of specialist trained officers with relation to motoring offences and vehicle safety. They were tasked with enforcing ASB in vehicles, defective vehicles, and similar offences.

Several vehicles were stopped and checked by officers. 11 Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) were issued, these cover all endorsable offences, and included speeding and no insurance offences.

Further to the above 6 defective notices were issued and 1 vehicle was seized.

To have this team in Bungay is a bit of a coup, and is the result of many meetings and conversations with the SNT and other officers in the Suffolk Constabulary.

What must be mentioned again is the importance of calls logged to the 101 system, the more calls the more response.

Mick, Hugh Taylor of Beccles TC, and I also had a meeting last week with Supt. Tonya Antonis. This was a meeting arranged to be able to meet Supt. Antonis and to give her the low down on matters in Beccles and Bungay.

Issues discussed were ASB, speed watch and parking.
